PAPAL FOCUS

The Holy Father, speaking in St Peter's Square last Sunday at the Regina Coeli, again appealed for peace in Syria. He said: 'I am deeply troubled by the current world situation in which, despite the instruments available to the international community, there is still difficulty in agreeing to a common action in favour of peace in Syria and other regions of the world. While I continue to pray unceasingly for peace, and invite all people of good will to do the same, I renew my appeal to all those with political responsibilities to ensure that justice and peace prevail.'
