TODAY'S CELEBRATION

The theme chosen for the 53rd World Communications Day by the Holy Father is: 'We are members one of another' (Eph 4:25). From network community to human communities.' Underlining the importance of giving back to communication a broad perspective, the theme is based on the person, and emphasizes the value of interaction always understood as dialogue and as an opportunity to meet with others. The choice of the theme for the 2019 Message confirms Pope Francis' attention to the new communications environment and for social networks, especially, where he is present in the first person with his @Pontifex account on Twitter and @Franciscus on Instagram.
