#### TEACHING POINT

It's important to note that a genuflection is only necessary (outside of the liturgy of the Mass) when passing the tabernacle. This means a person should look out for the tabernacle, as the tabernacle may not be visibly present, in a side chapel (as it is in St Michael & St George), or even empty (as on Good Friday, when the Blessed Sacrament has been removed to the altar of repose, and we do not genuflect before the empty tabernacle). A good indication is to look for the lamp which is kept burning near the tabernacle when the Blessed Sacrament is present. There is no reason to genuflect when entering a church if you don't walk by a tabernacle. In those cases a simple bow to the altar is appropriate.
