HIGHER EDUCATION

Mater Ecclesiae College will open this Tuesday, 1st October in its new home at St Mary's University, Twickenham. In July of this year the Holy See, by a Decree of the Congregation for Catholic Education, transferred the Faculties of Theology and Philosophy from Heythrop College to St Mary's University with governance being transferred from the Society of Jesus to the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. This institution will remain the only faculties in the UK with the ability to confer ecclesiastical degrees - qualifications which are recognised universally throughout the Catholic Church.
