TODAY'S COMMEMORATION

World Mission Sunday is vital to the growth of the Church and the spread of the Gospel in predominately impoverished and remote areas overseas. The funds raised build much-needed infrastructure, from chapels and schools to orphanages, clinics and dispensaries. Requested by the local community, the support from Missio transforms lives and creates a hub from which the young Church can flourish and grow. World Mission Sunday is one of only three Papal collections and has been especially chosen by the Holy Father to support the mission of the Church in the world. In the third week of the Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM2019), Catholics are asked to reflect on 'Missionary charity as a commitment to support the Church's missionary activity and communities too poor to support themselves.'
