A multifaceted mix of wartime heroism, penitential spirituality, practical joker and a tender care for his fellow humans, Wille Doyle continues to fascinate people today, one hundred years on from his death in the First World War. Many draw attention to his sense of humour, positive attitude and upbeat disposition which supported the soldiers to whom he was Chaplain during dark and dangerous times in the trenches of WWI.
