# PAPAL COMMUNICATION

In a message to Bishop Alexis Shirama of Hiroshima, on the occasion of the 80th anniversary of the atomic bomb on Hiroshima, Pope Leo XIV urges the international community to renew its commitment to abandon nuclear weapons and pursue lasting peace for our whole human family. # **DUTIFUL CELEBRATION**

The Catholic Church teaches as dogma that the Virgin Mary "having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory". This doctrine was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII on 1 November 1950, in the apostolic constitution *Munificentissimus Deus* by exercising papal infallibility. Item 39 points to the Book of Genesis (3:15) as scriptural support for the dogma in terms of Mary's victory over sin and death as also reflected in 1 Corinthians 15:54: "then shall come to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory". The holy days of obligation for Latin Rite Catholics are indicated in canon 1246 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law and include the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
