### TODAY'S COMMEMORATION

The World Day of the Poor was established by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter, *Misericordia et Misera*, on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2016. In 2025 Pope Leo XIV takes as his theme the Psalmist's cry "You, O Lord, are my hope" (Ps 71:5) and urges us to recognise those experiencing poverty as "witnesses to a strong and steadfast hope, precisely because they embody it in the midst of uncertainty, poverty, instability and marginalisation". Reflecting on the Jubilee Year of Hope, the Holy Father calls on us to ensure that the closing of the Holy Door does not mean an end to action. Those experiencing poverty remain "not recipients of our pastoral care, but creative subjects who challenge us to find novel ways of living out the Gospel today."
