Pope Francis has called for a day of prayer and fasting tomorrow, Monday 7th October, to mark the one-year anniversary of the Hamas attack on Israel amid escalating violence in the region. In it he reflected that the Church is always at the service of humanity, "especially in his dramatic hour of our history, as the winds of war and the fires of violence continue to ravage entire peoples and nations."
