#### ARMISTICE COMMEMORATION

In a return to custom, there will be a Service of Remembrance in the Cathedral on Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> November beginning at 1030hrs, to which everyone is welcome. Regular and Reserve personnel are invited to wear uniform on this occasion. The Sunday Vigil Mass will be celebrated at 1800hrs on Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> November with a Mass for the Fallen at 0800hrs on Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> November.

#### MOVING FORWARD

Following discussion with +Paul, and in anticipation of no change in Government or Bishops' Conference advice, it's been agreed that from the First Sunday of Advent, 28<sup>th</sup> November, the day on which the Obligation for the Faithful to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is reinstated, the wearing of face coverings in the Cathedral will be a matter of personal choice. Also from that day Track and Trace will cease. The reintroduction of coffee, tea and biscuits at the back of church commences after Mass today, and the Children's Liturgy will start again on Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> November.
