HCPT Pilgrimage

HCPT will not be proceeding with the 2021 Easter children's pilgrimage. However, it is hoped, if conditions allow, to conduct 2 children's pilgrimages to Lourdes in 2021 over 25 – 31 Jul and 24 – 30 Oct. International Military Pilgrimage

We hope to hold the first Mass at the Cathedral Church of the Bishop of the Forces, Aldershot in March with the second taking place at the RAF Church, St Clement Danes, in October.
