A multifaceted mix of wartime heroism, penitential spirituality, practical joker and a tender care for his fellow humans, Wille Doyle continues to fascinate people today, one hundred years on from his death in the First World War. Some admire his selflessness, others are attracted to his deep spirituality and desire to bring the word of God to the broadest possible audience. Many draw attention to his sense of humour, positive attitude and upbeat disposition which supported the soldiers to whom he was Chaplain during dark and dangerous times in the trenches of WWI. A new booklet by Patrick Corkery SJ, entitled Willie Doyle SJ: 'Much in the Presence of God' offers a multidimensional portrayal of a man who touched the lives of so many.
