It's been an annual opportunity to express concern for different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for them as they face many challenges; and to increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers. The Vatican has a dedicated section for Migrants and Refugees, directed personally by the Holy Father and aims to help the Church, and others, to accompany those forced to flee and make sure they are not shut out or left behind.
