### PAPAL VISIT

Addressing pilgrims in St Peter's Square after the Angelus last Sunday, Pope Francis looked ahead to his apostolic journey to Canada (beginning today until 30<sup>th</sup> July), describing it as "a penitential pilgrimage" that will hopefully contribute to a process of healing and reconciliation with the country's indigenous peoples. He went on to explain that "Unfortunately, in Canada, many Christians, including some members of religious institutes, have contributed to the policies of cultural assimilation that, in the past, have severely harmed indigenous communities in various ways." The Pope expressed thanks for the preparatory work that is underway "and for the welcome you will give me." "Thank you all! And I ask you to please accompany me with your prayers."

### CHANGES AFOOT

Next Sunday, 31<sup>st</sup> July will be our last celebration of Mass in the Cathedral for the next three months. The scheme of work to refurbish all of the parquet flooring and the marble in the sanctuary, the repair and reconditioning of all of the stained glass, either in-situ or by being removed to a workshop, the painting of all of the walls and radiators the same colour, the laying of oak panels in the sanctuary, the repair of all of the outside stone steps, the installation of new units and facilities in the vestry as well as repainting and reorganising of the sacristy, is planned to begin on Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> August and be complete by 11<sup>th</sup> November. Joining with our brothers and sisters in sharing St Andrew's Church our Mass will begin at 0930hrs on Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> August (and every Sunday), with the church being opened each weekday and mid-week services taking place as advertised in the Newsletter.
