FAITHFUL WITNESS

Pope Francis arrived in the Kazakh capital of Nur-Sultan last Tuesday evening, for the start of his 38th Apostolic Journey, marking the 57th country he has visited since the his pontificate began. Coming as a 'pilgrim of peace', the Holy Father's visit is focussing on peace, unity, and interreligious dialogue.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

The theme for the World Week for Peace in Palestine and Israel, which is being observed from 15th to 22nd September, is "Faith, Hope and Love in Action: Towards Justice in Israel Palestine." In 2022 the theme is anchored in active hope and in striving for a better future with no occupation. It builds on the theme of the World Council of Churches 11th Assembly, "Christ's love moves the world to reconciliation and unity."
