PAPAL PROCLAMATION

Pope Francis on the Solemnity of St Peter & St Paul published an Apostolic Letter: 'Desiderio desideravi' on the Liturgy, recalling the profound meaning of Eucharistic celebrations and encouraging liturgical formation. The Letter elaborates on the results of the February 2019 plenary of the Dicastery of Divine Worship and follows the motu proprio 'Traditionis custodes.' In his Apostolic Letter Pope Francis reaffirms the importance of ecclesial communion around the rite that emerged from the post-conciliar liturgical reform. It is not a new instruction or a directive, but rather a meditation on understanding the beauty of liturgical celebration and its role in evangelization.
