World Youth Day (WYD) is a global gathering where young people deepen their faith, experience the universality of the Catholic Church, and commit their lives to Christ alongside hundreds of thousands of like-minded peers.

WYD 2023 took place in Lisbon in Portugal in August. A group of 10 personnel from the Whole Force joined with the Bishop of the Armed Forces, Bishop Paul Mason, Fr Ian Stevenson (Army PRCC), the Holy Father, Pope Francis, and over 1 million other pilgrims for this week-long event. The memories of those who attended will live long in the memory.
