TODAY'S COMMEMORATION

The fifty days of the sacred season of Easter conclude with Pentecost Sunday, when the Universal Church recalls the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles and the start of the Church's mission to all tongues and peoples and nations. The Easter candle is kept in the baptistery from today so that the candles of the baptised may be lit from it during their baptism. At funerals it is placed near the coffin, to signify that Christian death is a true Passover.
