FOSTERING FAITH

The Temple Church in London and Co-Cathedral of the Most Holy Name of Jesus in Jerusalem were the settings for a simultaneous ecumenical service last week, marking the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea. The event featured a livestream broadcast from the two churches. At the Council of Nicaea, in the year 325, church leaders formally assembled to agree on Christian doctrine and endorse the Nicene Creed. PAPAL COMMUNICATION
