PAPAL APPOINTMENTS

Pope Francis has named three women to the Dicastery for Bishops - the first time women have been appointed to this Vatican office, responsible for identifying future bishops globally. The three women are: Sr Raffaella Petrini, FSE, Secretary General of the Governorate of the Vatican City State; Sr Yvonne Reungoat, FMA, former Superior General of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians; and Dr Maria Lia Zervino, President of the World Union of Catholic Women's Organizations.

FORTHCOMING CELEBRATION

A military ordinariate is an ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the Catholic Church, of the Latin or an Eastern church, responsible for the pastoral care of Catholics serving in the armed forces of a nation. Until 1986, they were called 'military vicariates and had a status similar to that of apostolic vicariates, which are headed by a bishop who receives his authority by delegation from the Pope. The apostolic constitution of 21st April 1986, *Spirituali militum curae*, raised their status, declaring that the bishop who heads one of them is an 'ordinary, holding authority by virtue of his office, and not by delegation from another person in authority. It likened the military vicariates to dioceses. The Military Vicariate of the United Kingdom was created on 21st November 1953 and elevated to become the Bishopric of the Forces on 21st July 1986.
